### Kindergarten Readiness

Does your child...

- have the confidence to separate from a parent or caregiver and stay with another adult?
- share with others willingly?
- problem solve and communicate needs?
- play alone without adult assistance?
- cooperate with other children and adults?
- work individually and in small groups?
- finish what he/she starts?



### Kindergarten Readiness

- · Counts 10 objects and recognizes numbers 1-10
- Knows shapes and colors
- Sit and stay on task for 10-15 minutes (not including screen activities)
- Listens to a story or participates in an activity and responds to questions related to that activity
- Follows simple two step directions
- · Can color in the lines
- · Recognizes his/her own name




### Academic Readiness

- · Shows an interest in print and books
- Has begun to write name in upper and lower case letters
- Uses pencils, crayons, scissors, glue sticks and markers at home
- · Begins to draw recognizable objects



### Verbal Communication


- Can your child use language to express personal needs?
- Is your child's language clearly understood by other adults beyond just family members?
- Express him/herself verbally
- Speak in complete sentences
- · Does your child engage other children and adults in conversation?



### Hygiene Skills


- Washes hands
- · Uses a tissue independently
- Attends to bathroom needs with total independence






### Personal Autonomy

- Dresses self
- Feeds self
- · Cleans up after self
- · Zips, buttons, snaps
- Carries, opens, and closes own backpack





### Kindergarten Readiness Act

- For the 2024-25 school year: Any child who turns 5 on or between September 2nd and June 2 is eligible for TK
  - Children who turn 5 years old on or after June 2nd are eligible for preschool
  - \*The District does not implement early admittance into TK, and will not accept any child who is younger than the TK eligibility dates.
- Children who turn 5 years old on or before September 1st are eligible for Kindergarten
  - Children who turn 5 years old between June 1 and
     September 1st can apply for TK instead of Kindergarten,
     but admittance will be dependent on space in the program
    - Obligation to place all TK-eligible students first;

      Higher-eligible students will be placed in late May/early

      June\* (\*Timelines subject to change)

### Kindergarten Readiness


- Watch for classes offered in the summer through the district, for a fee.
- District will have information on their website when it becomes available.






### Baseline Assessment

- · Time will be available in August
- 15min. One-on-one with a Kindergarten Teacher
- Results will be used to balance the classes and structure curriculum then shared with you at Fall conference time in Oct.

### **Student Benefits**

### Academic and Social Benefits of EDK

- Research shows EDK results in greater reading and math gains than half day programs
- Longer day allows students to build a solid educational foundation
- More time for support of students at-risk
- Research shows that 5-year olds are more than ready for a longer day and do better in a setting that allows them time to learn and explore activities in depth
- Increased time for socialization (imagination, play, etc.)

77% of Kindergarten's across the nation are Full Day

### **Student Benefits**

#### Academic and Social Benefits of EDK

- K standards are rigorous, more time for instruction to reach standards
- Reduced number of transitions in the day (compared to EB/LO model)
- Opportunity for Digital Literacy, Hands-on Science (STEM, gardening, labs),
   Music, Art, P.E., older peer interaction/buddies
- Research shows that EDK students have better attendance, self-confidence, and better ability to work and play with other.

70% of Kindergartens in California are Full Day

### Parent Benefits of EDK

- For working parents, fewer transportation challenges
- For parents with older children, siblings will begin and end at the same time
- Confidence that child is receiving more instruction
- For working parents, reduced costs for child care
  - Or elimination of cost altogether
